Recommendations for Using Everything DiSC on iPad

Important Note: Not all Everything DiSC products support Mac and iPad. Only those providing a folder titled, "Mac_iPad" on the USB drive, such as Work of Leaders, have the files designed in Apple software to function on iPads and Macs without Flip4Mac software.

iPad devices use app versions of the Apple software used to create the Mac_iPad versions of Everything DiSC materials, resulting in limited functionality.

iPad compatibility is meant as a convenience for classroom presentation purposes. There are several benefits of Everything DiSC facilitation materials that iPad doesn't support to the fullest extent. We recommend that you do all of your prework and customizing on your Mac or PC; this includes printing or making changes to leader's guides and handouts and customizing Keynote® slides.

Leader's guides and handouts are provided as Pages® documents for Mac. The iPad runs Pages as an iPad app. This causes issues with additional spacing that affects the pagination.

Podcasts and Build-Your-Own Video slides include individually selectable clips—you can listen/watch the whole thing or just one clip. However, on the iPad, you can't skip around easily and may have to toggle through several slides to get to the desired clip.

When you download Everything DiSC modules to your iPad, you will receive the warning shown below:

"Keynote doesn't support some aspects of the original presentation."

The warning will list one or both of the following reasons:

The font Wingdings-Regular is missing. Your text might look different. Slides were resized to fit. Your presentation might look different.

Please note that your presentation will still play. We have tested this numerous times and have not found any problems with the overall look of the presentation.

System Requirements:

You must have an iTunes® account on both your computer (Mac or PC) and your iPad. You will also need to have Keynote for iPad and/or Pages for iPad installed on your iPad depending on the types of files you wish to import. For download information, go to http://www.apple.com.
