## Transfer Everything DiSC Files to iTunes for iPad

Since an iPad has no USB port, Everything DiSC facilitation files must be transferred to it using a computer and your iTunes account.

Insert the Everything DiSC USB drive into one of your computer's USB ports.

Open iTunes.

Connect your iPad to your computer using a second USB port and your iPad cable. The iPad and iTunes will begin syncing immediately.

Click on the iPad listed under **Devices** in the menu on the left side of the iTunes screen.

Then click **Apps** under the Apple image at the top of the screen.



Scroll down to **File Sharing** and select **Keynote**. Click on **Add** at the bottom-right of the documents window and browse to locate the Everything DiSC USB drive.
